1. God created us to be fruitful and multiply.

Gen. 9:7 “As for you, be fruitful and multiply; Populate the earth abundantly and multiply in it.” (Gen. 1:28)

2. God created us to work.

Gen. 2:15 “Then the LORD God took the man and put him into the garden of Eden to cultivate it and keep it.”

Hebrew word *avodah* means worship, serve, and work. Translators have to pick one use of this word because other languages don't have a word that means all three.
