- 1. Listen to the LORD (26:2).
- 2. Habitual sin is often passed on (26:6-11).
- 3. Sometimes people of the world-system are afraid of the power of God in us (26:16).

Luke 10:5-6, Col. 4:5-6

- 4. Sometimes settle disagreements with people of the world-system by moving on (26:17-22).
- 5. Encouragement from the LORD sometimes precedes encounters with people from the world (26:23-33).

Gen. 14:17-24

- 6. Family can be the biggest persecution in our lives (26:34-35).
- 7. We do not need to trick the LORD into fulfilling His promises (27:1-29)
- 8. People of the world can become bitter when justice arrives (27:36, Esau gave up his birthright).
- 9. People of the world will stop at nothing, no matter how immoral (27:41, Cain, Lamech, Nimrod, etc).
- 10. More scheming with sad consequences (27:42-46).
