"Fulfilling the Law" Romans 8:1-13

Numbers in parenthesis () are verses in Romans Chapter 8

1. No condemnation. (1-3)

"condemnation" only used elsewhere in Rom. 5:16, 18 We have no condemnation: Rom. 5:2, 6:13; John 5:24

Bible has verses of condemnation: Eze. 18:4, 20; 1 Thess. 1:6-9;

Rom. 6:23; Heb. 9:27; Matt. 10:28 Christ is the only way: Acts 4:12, John 14:6

1. Law of the Spirit of Life set us free (2-3) "likeness" because Jesus had no sin: 1 Pet. 2:22;

2 Cor. 5:21; 1 John 3:5

2. Not the Law (3)

2. We fulfill the requirement of the Law (4-13)

- 1. if we don't walk according to the flesh
 - 1. not setting our minds on the things of the flesh (5) Rom. 12:1; John 3:6; 1 Cor. 2:14; Gal. 5:22, 25
 - 2. leads to death (5) Rom. 7:24; John 11:39; 2 Cor. 7:1
 - 3. hostile to God (7)
 - 4. does not subject to the law of God (7)
 - 5. cannot subject to the law of God (7)
 - 6. cannot please God (8)

Holy Spirit in believers: 1 Cor. 3:16; 6:19; Gal. 4:6

7. not under any obligation to live to the flesh, which would be death (12-13)

2. but walk according to the Spirit

- 1. setting minds on things of the Spirit (5)
- 2. leads to life and peace (6)
- 3. if saved, have the Spirit (9)

Acts 19:1-6: we act like John's non-indwelt disciples Examine yourselves: 2 Cor. 13:5

- 4. body dead because of sin but spirit is alive because of righteousness (10)
- 5. Spirit Who raised Jesus raises us to life now (11) Life from the Holy Spirit now: Rom. 6:4, 8, 11]

Life for the mortal body in the future: 1 Cor. 6:14; 15:42, 53; 2Cor. 4:14]

Holy Spirit in Jesus' life: Heb. 9:14, Rom. 1:4, Acts 1:2

Holy Spirit in our life: 2 Cor. 3:18, 1 Cor. 12

- 7. putting to death the deeds of the body (13)
