12:9 – only occurrence in these back-and-forth discourses of LORD (Yahweh).

12:13-25 – “Job launches into a majestic recital of the Lord's sovereignty, wisdom, and strength, and how they often produce inexplicable and paradoxical results.” (MacDonald)

13:5-6 – Silence is good for counselors and everyone, Prov. 17:28.
